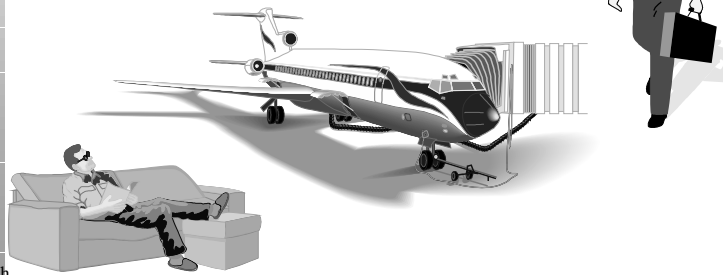
- **3rd European Agent Systems Summer School (EASSS 2001)**
